 - o its: a possessive pronoun meaning "belonging to it."
 - o it's: a contraction meaning "it is."
- their / there / they're
 - o their: a possessive pronoun meaning "belonging to them."
 - o there: a place, or used with the verb to be ("is there," "were there.")
 - o they're: a contraction meaning "they are."
- to / too / two
 - o to: a preposition meaning "toward," also used with infinitive forms of verbs, such as "to say," "to do," etc.
 - o too: overly, extremely; also
 - o two: the number 2
- your / you're
 - o your: a possessive pronoun meaning "belonging to you."
 - o you're: a contraction meaning "you are."
- Other frequently confused homonyms: brake / break; hear / here; knew / new; know / no; passed / past; peace / piece; plain / plane; right / write; than / then; threw / through; wear / where; weather / whether; who's / whose.

<u>Other confusing words</u>: accept / except; advice / advise; affect / effect; among / between; fewer / less; were / where; then / than
